

## [“Greek and Roman Myths Depicted on Chinese Porcelains”](#)

This video (<https://youtu.be/Bn-Hp8B0GVE>) was created by the staff of the Hong Kong Palace Museum to accompany an exhibit entitled “Botticelli to Van Gogh: Masterpieces from the National Gallery, London,” November 22, 2023 to April 11, 2024 (<https://www.hkpm.org.hk/en/exhibition/botticelli-to-van-gogh-masterpieces-from-the-national-gallery-london>). Several pieces of art included in that exhibit depict scenes from Ovid's *Metamorphoses*. The curators in Hong Kong were looking for ways to make this artwork more relevant to their Hong Kong audience and in an internet search they came across work by Will Motley of Cohen & Cohen (London) and Thomas J. Sienkewicz of Monmouth College (IL) on scenes from Ovid depicted on 18th century Chinese Export Porcelain. This led to a collaboration by Motley and Sienkewicz with the museum staff to create this video, which is on display in the gallery with the NG paintings.
