*cephal-* (cephalodynia)

*blepharo-* (blepharospasm)

*ocul-* (ocular, oculomotor)

*nas-* (nasal)

*rhin-* (rhinitis)

*aur-* (aural, auricle)

*ot-* (otoscope)

*bucc-* (buccal, buccinator)

*os, or-* (oral)

*labi-* (labial, labiodental)

*cervic-* (cervical)
